

Financial aid information request form for the 2015–2016 school year

Important information for students and parents from the Indiana Education Savings Authority

Did you know...

... that along with all of the tax advantages you can get from a CollegeChoice 529 Direct Savings Plan account, the assets in your account might not affect your student's chances of receiving state financial aid?

According to Indiana law, and under certain conditions (see criteria list to the right), the amount of money available in a CollegeChoice 529 account and the proposed use of money in that account on behalf of a beneficiary may not be included when determining state grant award eligibility.

Since federal law requires that 529 plan assets be included on a FAFSA, information is needed directly from the account owner and the beneficiary to properly calculate a student's eligibility.

NOTE: To be considered for the 2015-2016 school year, the CollegeChoice 529 Direct Savings Plan financial aid information request form must be faxed by the deadline of **March 31, 2015**.

Complete the form **ONLY** if:

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) has been filed and received by the Federal Processor by **March 10, 2015**; and
- The account owner is a parent who has completed the 2015-2016 FAFSA for their child; *and* the child is a student planning to attend an Indiana post-secondary institution that is eligible* to receive state aid for the 2015-2016 year; *and* is an Indiana resident; **or**
- The student has completed the 2015-2016 FAFSA; *and* is considered an independent student for financial purposes; *and* is planning to attend an Indiana post-secondary institution that is eligible* to receive state aid for the 2015-2016 year; *and* is an Indiana resident.

CollegeChoice 529's Portfolios invest in: (i) mutual funds; or (ii) an FDIC-insured omnibus savings account held in trust by the Authority at Sallie Mae Bank. Except for the Savings Portfolio, investments in CollegeChoice 529 are not insured by the FDIC. Units of the Portfolios are municipal securities and the value of units will vary with market conditions.

Investment returns will vary depending upon the performance of the Portfolios you choose. - The current account owner is a parent: **1)** who has completed the 2015-2016 FAFSA for their child as a **dependent** for financial aid purposes; *and* **2)** whose student plans to attend an Indiana post-secondary institution that is eligible* to receive state aid for the 2015-2016 year; *and* **3)** both the parent and student are Indiana residents; **OR**
- The student is considered **independent** for financial aid purposes *and:* **1)** has completed the 2015-2016 FAFSA (no parental information); *and* **2)** plans to attend an Indiana post-secondary institution that is eligible* to receive state aid for the 2015-2016 year; *and* **3)** is a permanent Indiana resident.
