

THE NH ABLE PLAN PRIVACY NOTICE

The Office of the New Hampshire State Treasury and the New Hampshire Governor's Commission on Disability (the "NH ABLE Savings Account Program Administrators") and The NH ABLE Plan (the "Plan") respect your right to privacy and want you to know how we handle your personal information. The Plan is administered by the NH ABLE Savings Account Program Administrators. The NH ABLE Savings Account Program Administrators, The New Hampshire ABLE Plan, its employees, contractors, agents, and subcontractors collect personal information, such as name, address, telephone number, Social Security Number, Taxpayer ID, or email address (collectively, "Personal Information") about you from the following sources:

- Information you or your representative provide to us on a voluntary basis when you conduct business with the Plan, its agents, or subcontractors whether online, through the mail, or over the phone;
- Information received from the Social Security Administration, the Internal Revenue Service, other state or federal programs, or state agencies; and
- Information received from third party payment processors to which you have made contributions or withdrawals.

How We Protect Information About You

Access by our employees, contractors, agents, and subcontractors to your Personal Information is only on a need to know basis on the understanding that it is confidential business information. The NH ABLE Savings Account Program Administrators, the Plan, its employees, contractors, agents, and subcontractors do not disclose Personal Information to third parties, except with your consent, at your request, or as authorized to do so by law or by contract.
